Registration will begin shortly for the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual PSA SHOOTOUT. When you see the registration form updated with the 2008 information, you may send in your registration. Please remember that we do not accept any registrations by phone or e-mail. You will not be registered until we receive your completed registration form and payment.

As we gear up for the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual PSA SHOOTOUT, there are a few changes this year that should be aware of before you register.

First, we have changed the Stock Revolver division to 6-shot revolvers. You may still shoot your 7 and 8-shot revolvers, but must do a mandatory reload after 6 shots are fired. The RO's will be counting shots and checking moonclips for unfired shots. Any shooter who has fired more than 6 shots before reloading, will be assessed a 10-second penalty for each shot fired.

Second, we have changed the Shooters Party on Saturday night. Instead of a dinner, we will be doing a FREE pizza and sub party ... and of course beer and sodas. PSA will be picking up the tab in honor of our 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Please indicate on your registration form if you will be attending. This will be the only way to know how many pizzas and subs we will need.

Also new this year is the addition of a center-fire handgun side match. With four side matches to shoot, please plan on spending some extra time at the range. The side matches will be geared for speed. So bring lots of ammo!

The match T-shirt this year will be black, with white logos/lettering. Instead of sweatshirts, there will be a long sleeve T-shirt (with match logos) available. If you wish to purchase the long sleeve shirt in addition to the free match T-shirt, please check the appropriate box on the registration form.

If you have a number of shooters who would like to be squadded together, please remember to indicate that on your registrations. It is not necessary to send all your registrations in one envelope. Pick a "squad leader" and reference that person on your registration forms. As many of you know, if you wait a few days to put your group together, there is a good chance that the day/time you want to shoot will be full.

PLEASE, PLEASE, do not send your registration by any courier method where the envelope needs to be signed for. This will only delay the arrival of your registration (and save me many trips to the Post Office).
