MATCH INFORMATION

The match will consist of 6 stages, 25-35 targets **PER** stage. All knockdown steel will be used

STARTING TIMES: 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM each day. Squads will be limited to 17 shooters per squad (102 shooters PER time slot). If the time slot you requested is filled, you will be notified and given the option to select another day/time.

PLEASE GET YOUR ENTRIES IN EARLY.

FIVE DIVISIONS

<u>OPEN AUTO</u> - Any centerfire semi auto pistol. All modifications and optics allowed. No more than 10 rounds in gun to start. No more than 10 rounds in a magazine at any time.

OPEN REVOLVER - Any centerfire revolver. All modifications and optics allowed.

STOCK AUTO – Centerfire semi-auto. No comps, ports or external weights, regardless of source, i.e., factory ported. No optics. No more than 10 rounds in gun to start. No more than 10 rounds in a magazine at any time.

<u>STOCK REVOLVER</u> – 6-round limit. No comps, ports or external weights regardless of source, i.e., factory ported. No optics. You may use a 7 or 8-shot revolver, as long as you only shoot 6 rounds and then reload. You will be penalized 10 seconds for every shot over 6 before a reload.

<u>PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE</u> - No magazine round limit. Chamber flags and bags are required. All modifications, braces and optics allowed

Shooters may shoot in all five divisions and be eligible for prizes in five divisions; however, you must shoot in five different time slots.

REGISTRATION: To guarantee a shooting slot, you must PRE-REGISTER. YOU WILL NOT BE REGISTERED UNTIL THE REGISTRATION FORM AND PAYMENT ARE RECEIVED. NO PHONE OR E-MAIL REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED. Walk-on shooters will be accommodated ONLY if there are openings.

ENTRY FEES: \$60.00 one gun; \$110.00 two guns; \$160.00 three guns ;etc.. Refunds will be given if notified of cancellation **at least 1 day before** time slot.

FREE <u>PSA SHOOTOUT</u> T-SHIRT to every shooter who <u>submits registration and payment before March 22</u>.

<u>PAYBACK</u> – Minimum 45% cash payback by Lewis Class. If entries warrant, High Ladies, Juniors (16 and under) and Seniors (60+) will also be paid.

SPORTING CLAYS will also be available at the club. Sporting Clays will run on Saturday from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Cost is \$15.00 for 50 birds.

LUNCH will be available on-site all four days. (10am to 2:30pm)

CLUB RULES PROHIBIT ANYONE FROM CONSUMING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNTIL YOU ARE FINISHED SHOOTING FOR THE DAY.

RULES

- 1. All shooters must check in a t the registration window at least 30 minutes prior to each starting time for each registered slot, even if you shot an earlier time slot.
- 2. Shooters **must** attend mandatory shooters meeting 15 minutes prior to each starting time.
- 3. NO RE-ENTRIES in the same division.
- 4. Open & Stock Auto: No more than 10 rounds in gun to start. No more than 10 rounds in a magazine at any time. **Penalty: 5 seconds per extra round**
- 5. Eye and ear protection is required for all shooters and spectators.
- 6. Start with gun in hand, muzzle touching table, finger off the trigger. If the gun has a external safety it must be applied. Shooters may take a loaded sight picture. NO drawing from a holster.
- 7. Shooter's feet must remain on the mat at the shooters table. **Penalty: Relay DQ**
- 8. At start signal, begin shooting, continuing to shoot, reloading as necessary until ALL targets are down or the par time (90 seconds) has been reached. Time will end on last shot fired. If there are any targets standing, the time is automatically the par time (90 seconds) + penalties (5 seconds per target standing) Mission: Knock down ALL the steel
- 9. Reload from belt or table. Shooter's choice. During reload finger must be outside trigger guard. **Penalty: Relay DQ**
- 10. A N Y ammo, magazine, moon clip, etc. that falls to the ground is **D E A D** and cannot be picked up during the run by the shooter or any squad member. **Penalty: Relay DQ**
- 11. ALL targets are knockdown and must fall. Any target left standing will incur a 5- second penalty. Targets will be set for minimum power factor. (However, we do recommend a 130 power factor.) [Power Factor = (Velocity * Bullet Weight) / 1000]
- 12. RO can declare a target dead in the event of a range equipment malfunction.
- 13. Come prepared with enough magazine/speed loaders to complete the **ENTIRE** stage without reloading mags, or having someone else reloading mags, during the run.
- 14. NO RESHOOTS and NO ALIBIS after the first shot is fired on a stage.
- 15. PCC only 9mm, 40 S&W and .45 cal Safety Flag and Bag
- 16. This is a **COLD range**. No loaded firearms or gun handling off the firing line except for the designated tables below. This is both shooters and spectators. **Penalty: Relay DO**

The following tables will be located at each pit:

<u>Gun handling table</u> – You may handle your gun at this table

NO AMMO AT THIS TABLE

Reloading table – You may load your magazines/speed loaders at this table

NO GUN HANDLING in the parking lot

ANY UNSAFE GUN HANDLING OR FAILURE TO FOLLOW RANGE OFFICER (RO) INSTRUCTIONS WILL RESULT IN A RELAY DISOUALIFICATION OR MATCH DISOUALIFICATION.

Example but not limited to:

1) Any shots striking the shooters table

2) Any accidental discharge

3) Early shot. Shooting before the buzzer sounds

4) Any flagrant safety violations

There will be designated gun handling areas. No ammo is allowed in these areas. Any handling of guns outside of these designated areas will result in disqualification.
